As you may be aware, in the Pacific Alliance Cali Declaration our heads of State expressed their satisfaction in lauching these negotiations with a view to granting Australia, Canada, New Zealand and Singapore the status of Associated States to The Pacific Alliance: " through the observance and implementation of agreements with high quality standards in trade disciplines".

The first round of negotiations will take place in Cali, from the 23rd to 27th October, 2017. Cali is one of the largest cities in Colombia. It is well- known for *salsa*. There are also restaurants, shops and other places of interest for tourists. We welcome you to this multi - ethnic and warm venue. We hope you enjoy your stay.

Pharmacy - Droguería S&S is located on the 2nd floor.





Taxi services

The following applications are available. We recommend not to take cabs on the street, but rather to request the service through these applications. As indicated above, to go to the meeting venue and back to the hotel it is better to use the shuttle, as cabs may not be easily available at the meeting facility.

In Colombia the voltage is 110 V. The frequency is 60 Hz. The plugs and sockets are A / B type. The following pictures show the types of plugs (plugs and sockets).







Currency and Banking

The Colombian currency is called "Colombian peso (COP)". One USD is equivalent to approximately 2.850 colombian pesos.

Payments in shops and restaurants shall be made in Colombian pesos.

Most foreign currencies can be exchanged at banks, bureaux de change, and hotels.

You can find ATMs at the meeting venue, as well as on the street, in pharmacies, supermarkets and shopping malls.

Credits Cards

American Express, Diners Club, MasterCard Visa, Visa and other major credit cards are widely accepted by hotels, restaurants, and shops. However, some restaurants and small shops only accept cash payments.
